**90 points**

This wine has the slightest hue of pink in the glass, and shows aromas of chalk, tangerine pith and botanical elements on the tightly wound nose. The palate is zippy with acidity, offering both red-apple and citrus flavors.

CHARDONNAY

**91 points**

Subtle at first on the nose, this bottling shows sharp yuzu, yellow apple and mineral tones on the focused nose. It's very taut on the palate, offering hints of Pink Lady and Gravenstein apple as well as a lemon rind kick.

PINOT NOIR

**92 points**

Rather light in the glass and shy in aromas at first, this bottling eventually reveals its delicate streak of pomegranate and dried rose petals on the nose. The fresh lightweight palate offers cranberry, pine needle and rosewater flavors, proving subtle, mellow and a great start for this new project on a historic chunk of land.



2016  
DICKINSON BLOCK  
ZINFANDEL

**92 points**

From a head-trained block of Zinfandel planted in 1906, this is a great wine even without that history. Elegantly earthy aromas of sage, dried red plums, vanilla brioche and black cherry Popsicle lead into a deep rich sip, where blueberry and tart black-plum skins decorate the creamy palate.
